### INDIAN ARTEFACTS



**Day 1: Australia - Buenos Aires (L\*)** Join Qantas and Lan Airlines for your flights to Buenos Aires, capital of Argentina.

**Day 2: Buenos Aires (B,D)** Your morning sightseeing tour includes the famous Colon Theatre, Plaza De Mayo and La Boca district with remainder of day at leisure until tonight's dinner and Tango Show!

**Day 3: Buenos Aires (B)** Today you will visit the quaint town of Colonia, Uruguay by fast ferry.

**Day 4: Buenos Aires - Iguassu River (B,D)** Fly to world's most spectacular waterfalls on Argentina - Brazil border. On arrival, you will explore the Argentinian side of the Falls and it's myriad of walkways.

**Day 5: Iguassu Falls - Rio de Janeiro (B)** Today an exhilarating tour to the Brazilian side of the Falls for a view that neither words nor photographs can do justice.

and scenic rail ride to the top of Cordova Mountain, followed by a cable car ride to the famous Sugar Loaf Mountain.

**Day 6: Rio de Janeiro (B,L)** Start with a panoramic drive

**Day 7: Rio de Janeiro (B)** Morning tour of favela, home to around 15% of Rio's population. Explore Santa Teresa and try a meal at Restaurant Aprazivel.

**Day 8: Rio de Janeiro - Paraty (B)** Drive the scenic coastline to beautiful National Historic Monument town of Paraty.

**Day 9: Paraty (B)** A free day to explore on your own. Optional schooner tours of the bay, stopping at island beaches, or walks into the hinterland.

**Day 10: Paraty - Lima (B,D\*)** Leisure morning, then head inland to pick up Via Dutra. Called "City of the Kings" by the conquistadors, Lima was the centre of the South American Spanish Empire.

**Day 11: Lima (B,L)** Start a tour of the city with lunch at El Rustico. Visit the Presidential Palace in Plaza de Armas, guarded by soldiers in full C18th uniform.

**Day 12: Lima - Ica (B,L)** Travel 300kms south of Lima to Ica. Rest of the day free to enjoy this fabulous resort. Opportunity to take the optional flight over the mysterious Nazca Lines.

**Day 13: Ica (B)** Join a cruiser tour to Ballestas and Guano Islands, viewing the wildlife, birds and ocean. See the giant candelabrum carved on the hill.

**Day 14: Ica - Cuzco - Sacred Valley (B)** Early this morning return to Lima and the airport for our flight to Cuzco, then onto the Sacred Valley of the Incas.

**Day 15: Sacred Valley (B,L)** Visit colonial Pisco, overlooked by ruins, the Moray and the Inca fortress at Ollantaytambo.

**Day 16: Sacred Valley to Machu Picchu (B)** Scenic rail trip to Machu Picchu beside the Urubamba river, parallel to the Inca Trail. Upon arrival a guided tour of the ruins.



**Day 17: Machu Picchu to Cuzco (B,L)** Leisure morning to explore the town of Aguas Calientes or perhaps revisit the "Lost City". A lunch is included before our train trip to Cuzco.

**Day 18: Cuzco (B)** A morning walking tour of the former capital of the Inca Empire and then visit the impressive ruins of the Sacsayhuaman fortress, overlooking the city.

**Days 19 & 20: Cuzco (B)** Two more days free to explore this amazing city. Your included tourist ticket gives you access to over 12 sites in and around Cuzco.

**Day 21: Cuzco - Puno (B,L)** Full day by coach along the Altiplano, visiting the "Sistine Chapel of the Americas", the La Raya Pass, at 4321m above sea level and Raqchi-old Inca storehouses, before arriving into Puno for overnight.

**Day 22: Puno - Copacabana (B,L,D)** Early morning cruise on Titicaca, world's highest navigable lake. Visit the Uros Indians living on the floating reed islands.

**Day 23 Copacabana (B)** Morning walking city tour before a cruise to Sun Island-the legendary birthplace of the Incas.

**Day 24 Copacabana - La Paz (B)** Spectacular trip by coach along the shores of the lake and then onto La Paz, the world's highest capital city.

**Day 25: La Paz (B,D)** Morning tour taking in the colonial sector, witchcraft market, residential zones and Moon Valley.

**Day 26: La Paz - Santiago (B,D\*)** Travel to Santiago.

**Day 27: Santiago (B,D\*)** Morning to explore Santiago before your flight home.

**Day 28: (B\*)** Cross International Date Line, arriving in Australia early the next day.
